


Traditional systems - Flat lock shingles

FL 4.1.04 Rear vented capping - rear 'T' plate.



All dimensions are indicative unless specified on the drawing Sheet thickness may be exaggerated for clarity

Scale 1/4 Notes:

'A' shows the wall coping attached to the top flat lock fold giving a very fine top seam to the façade.

- 'B' show the wall coping attached to a continuous galvanised fixing strip that permits the front face of the capping to be increased if desired, to tie in with other elements in the façade.
- Generic structural details are given for indicative purposes only.


