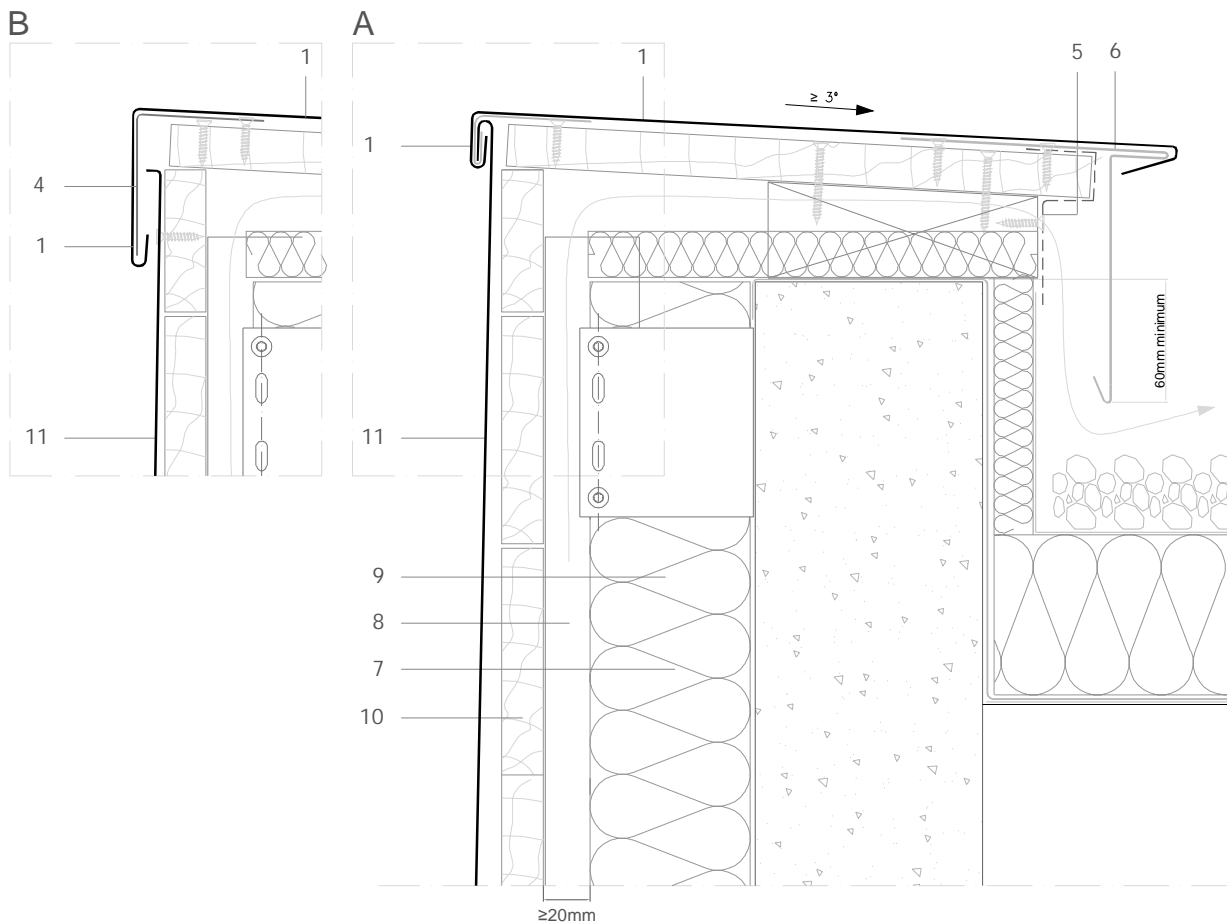


Traditional systems - Rhomboid Tile

T R 4.1.04 Rear vented capping - rear 'T' plate.



All dimensions are indicative unless specified on the drawing
Sheet thickness may be exaggerated for clarity

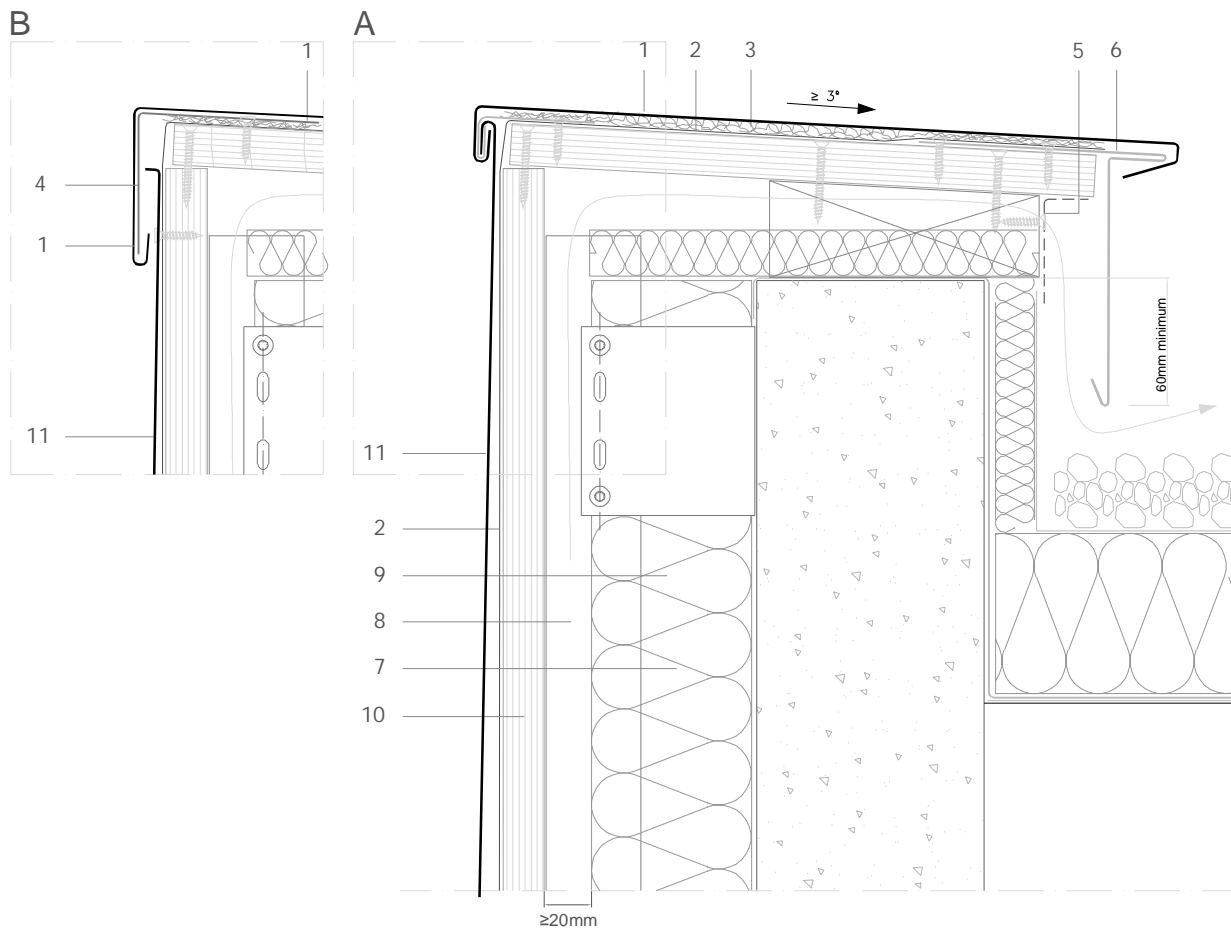
Notes:

- 'A' shows the wall capping hooked into the top row of the tiles to give a fine front edge to the cladding head.
- 'B' shows the wall capping lapped over the top row of tile.
- Wall capping front face in 'B' can be sized to match other elements of the façade such as corner pieces, window surrounds etc.
- See T R 4.1.01, 4.1.02 and 4.1.03 for alternative capping details.
- Generic structural details given for indicative purposes only.
